Firearm Handling Guidelines

- 1. Treat every firearm as if it were loaded.
- 2. Always keep your firearm pointed in a safe direction (muzzle control).
- 3. Prior to firing, be sure of your target and what is beyond it.
- 4. Always keep your finger off the trigger until you are on target and ready to fire.
- 5. Be sure your firearm is in a safe and operational condition (do your maintenance).
- 6. Know how to use your firearm and its safety features effectively.
- 7. Use only the correct ammunition for your firearm.
- 8. Never use drugs or alcohol before shooting (including some prescription medications that may dull your senses).
- Always be sure the barrel and action of your firearm are clear of obstructions.
- 10. Always carry your firearm so you can control the muzzle, even if you trip and fall.
- 11. Unattended firearms should be unloaded and cased, with ammunition stored separately from the firearm.
- 12. Never shoot at a flat hard surface such as water or frozen ground. Bullets can easily ricochet.
